

We Started in Silicon Valley

Founded in 2013, **CodePath** started as a technical training company for senior engineers. We ran engineering onboarding programs for the world's top tech companies including Facebook, Google, Dropbox, Airbnb, and Netflix. Our early students included the co-founder of Reddit, the former tech lead for Apple Watch, and the first mobile engineer at Coinbase.

Through redesigning Facebook University, we learned that the programming courses developed for professional engineers provided the missing curriculum and support to help college students persist and succeed in CS education.

In 2017, CodePath.com became **CodePath.org**, to eliminate inequity in college CS education.





CodePath's Expansion Strategy

CodePath will enable BLI, low-income, and first-generation college students to enter our nation's most competitive technical roles at the same rate as their representation in the general population. In the next 5 years, CodePath will:

Reach the majority of the 54,000 CS graduates* every year

80% of whom are from 120 universities with in-person courses and reach the remaining 453 institutions that graduate less than 20 students a year through our remote courses.

Scale programs that directly connect students to employment opportunities

We will match the size of our student population with opportunities through CodePath's Emerging Engineers Summit and our paid work + learning Pre-internship Program.

Build stronger relationships with university administrators to deliver systemic change

Cultivate relationships with CS Chairs, Deans,
